Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, Speech-Language Pathology, Psychology, and Psychiatry

Providing Nursing Services for Residential, Supported Apartments, and Family Care

STRIDES

(Individuals with Traumatic Brain Injuries)
ILST - Individual Living Skills Training, Medicaid Service Coordination, Intensive Behavioral Programming, and Community Integration Counseling

Respite, Family Reimbursement, Evening Recreation, Family Care, Saturday Recreation, Outreach/Prevention, Teen Recreation, and After School Program

Vocational/Educational Division

Vocational Assessment/Employment Screening, Youth Transition Services, College Mentor Program, Job Readiness Classes, Job Training, Community Based Assessment, Job Placement, Employment Support Services, and Wellsville Redemption Center

Residential Division

Individualized Residential Alternatives (IRAs)

IRAs - provide 24 hour staff oversight to 67 individuals located in Wellsville, Scio, Belmont and Alfred, and Supportive Apartments - teaches household management and independence skills

Adult Medicaid Service Coordination

Case Management, Advocacy, and Outreach; information and referral

Waiver Services

Day Habilitation

Teaches everyday living skills (including money and communication skills), Senior Citizens' program, Recreation/Social Activities, Green House, and Ceramics

At-Home Residential Habilitation

Teaches living and safety skills in the home environment (including mobility and financial/budgeting skills)

Vocational/Business Division

Contract Work Services

PWI Vocational Work Center, Community Based Employment, and At Your Service Contract Cleaning

Other Divisions

Transportation

Provides service and repairs for 9 buses and 90 agency vehicles; 265,000 miles traveled annually, Transports to and from Arc programs and other in-house events, Partner in the Access Allegany initiative, and has 8 runs open to the public including the Wellsville Express (www.alleganyarc.org/publictransportation)

Human Resources

Agency employs over 350 staff; 92% of staff live in Allegany County and over 125 individuals with special needs receive paychecks annually
