Day Services

Day Habilitation, Individualized Community Services, Respite, Evening Recreation, Family Care, Saturday Recreation, Teen Recreation, After School Program, and At-Home Residential Habilitation

Residential Services

IRA's - provide 24 hour staff oversight to 65+ individuals located in Wellsville, Scio, Belmont and Alfred, and Supportive Apartments - teaches household management and independence skills

Vocational/Educational Services

Vocational Assessment/Employment Screening, Youth Transition Services, College Mentor Program, Job Readiness Classes, Job Training, Community Based Assessment, Job Placement, and Employment Support Services

Support Services

Medicaid Service Coordination Case Management, Outreach/Prevention, Crisis Management, Family Reimbursement, and Parent & Family Support Network

Day Services Eligibility Checklist

- Application for Services
- Personal History
- Physical Examination Form (any version is acceptable) and proof of PPD (tuberculosis skin test) completed within last year.
- Over the Counter Form signed by physician
- Consent for Release of Confidential Information for anyone providing service outside of Allegany Arc (i.e. referring agency, physicians, other medical professionals, counselors, Allegany Rehabilitation Associates, probation, etc.)
- Psychological/Psychiatric Assessment completed within three years prior to start of service
- Educational information (i.e. Individualized Education Plan)*
- Vocational History / Work History*
- Adaptive Behavior Scale*
- Additional medical information for anyone with other medical conditions such as Traumatic Brain Injury.

Residential Services Eligibility Checklist

- Application for Services
